Areas of Application

The areas of application are dressed timber furniture, doors, veneers, wall panelling etc. Ideal for furniture and cabinet manufacture in production line joineries.

How to Apply

Pre Painting Steps



Remove all wax, grease and other contaminants by cleaning with mineral turps.



Fill the surface imperfections like nail holes, cracks etc by suitable filler. Sand smooth the surface and dust off.



Sand the surface uniformly along the grain marks and dust off.

Paint Application / System

- Stir the contents thoroughly before and during use.
- On new surface apply one or two coats of Instant Drying Sanding Sealer by spray. Carry out light sanding after thorough drying and dust off the area. Apply two uniform coats of Instant Drying Lacquer in desired finishes.
- On previously applied surfaces, apply two uniform coats of Instant Drying Lacquer with minimum 30 minutes recoating interval.
- For toning of wood grains, Transtain can be used appropriately prior to application of Instant Drying Sanding Sealer.
